UNESCO Chair Holders' Coordination Meeting – 2026

BNU, Lahore

Beaconhouse National University (BNU) hosted the UNESCO Chairholders' Coordination Meeting-2026 on the 1st of July in the Vice Chancellor Secretariat's boardroom at BNU, bringing together representatives of UNESCO Chairs from partner universities across Pakistan for a structured, day-long session of institutional review and collaborative planning.

Among the participating institutions, the UNESCO Chair on Low Carbon and Sustainable Agriculture in Biosphere Reserves-MNSUAM, presented a detailed account of its work to date. The presentation covered the Chair's team and international partners — including collaborators from the University of Sydney, Shihezi University, the University of Kassel, CAAS China, NUST, COMSATS, and MUET — alongside a published introductory booklet outlining the Chair's scope and mandate. A series of the Chair's high end achievements, its numerous Capacity-building activities and future road map was also highlighted in the presentation.

The coordination meeting concluded with a walkthrough of an on-campus exhibition and an exchange of institutional mementoes between BNU and visiting Chair holders, followed by a group photograph of all participants against the event's official backdrop — a fitting close to a day focused on strengthening cross-institutional cooperation among Pakistan's UNESCO Chairs.
